VISION

A one-stop accessible space for seniors to access up-to-date resources and information that will support their aging journey.

Key Elements:

- A coordinator who can assess needs, provide referrals & support navigating resources and services
- Potential space to manage assistive devices / equipment



WHY IT MATTERS

- Navigating the system and accessing resources is currently difficult
- Having one point of contact that provides support and assistance with finding and connecting with appropriate resources in a timely manner would help those in need as well as their caregivers
- Accessing appropriate resources in the timely manner has the potential to help seniors age in place longer



GETTING STARTED

- Identify potential partners
 - (Ex. Red Cross, NBCC Personal Support Worker & Practical Nurse Programs, Fundy Community Foundation, Vibrant Communities Charlotte County)
- Identify potential community space
- Obtain funding (through grants, government funding, fundraising, foundations, The Town of St. Andrews, etc.)

MOVING FORWARD

- Connect with the Red Cross seniors' program <u>The Connection New</u> <u>Brunswick program</u>, a HSPP Project offering a similar service. Review the research and explore potential partnership or adoption of the model
- Connect with the Age Friendly Community Committee
- Explore potential partnership with Passamaguoddy Lodge
- Connect with local professionals and organizations to provide healthy aging materials and programming
- Coordinate a list of professionals who can conduct regular healthy aging presentations
- Create standing partnership with NBCC PSW and PN students to provide ongoing education
- Seek out possible transportation services
